Hutchison Port Holdings (HPH), the port division of Hutchison Whampoa (HWL), is an industry leader in the application of technologies to strengthen the transportation and logistics chain. As the world's leading port developer and operator, the company operates in a total of 308 berths in 51 ports of call in 25 countries from Hongkong International Terminals (HIT), the world's largest privately owned container terminal, to the Port of Felixstowe, the largest container port in the United Kingdom. In 2009, the Ports segment accounted for 14 per cent of HWL's revenue and 27 per cent of HWL's earnings before interest expense and taxation.

In addition to being the largest port operator in the world, HPH is also one of the most innovative. For more than 40 years HPH has invested significant resources into information technology and security solutions to make its port operations more efficient, profitable and secure for customers and the countries where it does business. By continually investing in state-of-the-art technologies that boost productivity, HPH helps companies that ship goods through an HPH facility improve their efficiency, reduce costs and strengthen control of their customer and supplier relationship.
